PINs are coming!

As of April 23, you will need to set up a Personal Identification Number when you access your library account online. PINs add an extra layer of security by helping to prevent unauthorized use of your account.

NEW! Notary Services

The Library now offers notary services to the public in compliance with the Town's Notarization Policy. The notary at the library is able to: administer an oath; notarize acknowledgements; and notarize an affidavit.

For notary services to be fulfilled, two forms of identification are needed and at least one must have a photograph of the signer. Neither a social security card nor a birth certificate is to be used as a form of identification.

The signer MUST sign the document IN FRONT OF THE NOTARY in order to authenticate the signature.

The following documents are unable and prohibited to be notarized by the Library: a conveyance of land or property; living or general wills; birth, death or marriage certificates; or anything, from anyone, who is not appearing before us in person.

The fee for notarizing is \$5.00 as authorized by Connecticut General Statutes. We accept payment in cash or check. Check is to be made out to the Town of Mansfield.
